


Persian Language courses

The Global Center for Persian Studies at Shiraz University



An important city in Persian literary and Iranian intellectual history, Shiraz has been a hotspot for the arts and culture for centuries, and poets, philosophers, writers and artists have created their masterpieces here. Every year, thousands travel to Shiraz to visit the mausoleums of Hafiz and Sa'adi, Persepolis, Pasargadae, Zandiyeh historical complex, famed gardens, and numerous historical sites around the city.





Shiraz University was established more than seventy years ago, and is now a prestigious Iranian research University with an excellent track record in education and training. Shiraz University has for decades hosted learners of Persian, international students, scientists and scholars in various fields from around the world for decades.

The Global Center for Persian Studies is the only certified Center for teaching Persian in Shiraz, and has been registered as the Center for Teaching Persian to Non-Persian Speakers with the Ministry of Science, Research and Technology. For years, the Center has been offering Persian language training programs at all levels, as well as courses on Persian literature, Iranian arts and history.

Persian language programs are designed in short, middle and long modes, for students with basic,





intermediate and advanced knowledge of the language. Students have the option of attending individual or group classes. After successfully completing the advanced levels, students may further their training in courses tailored to their specific needs: some intend to do research on classical Persian literature, others want to read ancient Iranian languages or do research on cinema and arts, while others prepare for studying medicine or engineering.

Our lecturers are experienced, highly qualified and specifically trained to teach Persian as a foreign language. They take advantage of well-equipped language labs, audio-visual materials, teaching aids and technologies to enrich the learning experience of learners.

Students completing either of our training programs will receive a certificate, approved by the Ministry of Science, Research and Technology, which can be used for credit transfer to other Universities or institutions of higher education in the world.

Located on Eram hills right next to the world-famous Eram Garden, Shiraz University Campus has a unique view of the city, which makes students' stays pleasant and memorable. The language courses of the Global Center for Persian Studies are held at the International Campus, which offers a calm and quiet environment.
